MLA Style Guide for Internet & Electronic Resources

According to *MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers*, 6th ed., the citation for an electronic source should include the same information that would be listed for a print source or as much of that information as is available in the electronic format. The date the web site was accessed and the web address, placed in angle brackets, should be included at the end of the citation.

Included below are sample formats for citing Internet and electronic resources using MLA Style. These examples illustrate commonly encountered sources. Refer to the style manual for complete documentation.
